SHIP FINANCE



The GIA and its partner Singapore Maritime Foundation (SMF) is combining once more to organize the third in a series of seminars on the maritime sector aimed at general insurance industry professionals. On September 18, the next gathering at Capital Tower is entitled: "Ship Financing – trends in the Singapore and global markets".

The speakers will discuss a range of issues pertinent to the insurance sector and will outline some of the key developments in the financing of the global merchant fleet which have both a direct and indirect impact on the marine insurance market. These include the traditional method of debt financing or borrowing as well as the more recent development of equity financing and in particular the emergence in Singapore of stock listed shipping trusts and funds.

In both of these ways of raising money for new vessels, there are significant insurable interests and assets of which insurance practitioners should be aware. A leading ship financier and a representative from one of the newly listed shipping trusts will give the keynote speeches on these topics and Mr. David Chin, Executive Director of the SMF, will give an overview of the development of the Singapore market as an international ship finance centre."
