

# Vehicle Accident Report History (VARH)

## Frequently Asked Questions



### 1. Can I purchase a report if I'm not the owner of the vehicle?

No, the report for a vehicle can only be purchased by the registered owner at the time of purchase according to Myinfo records.

### 2. How much does the report cost?

The cost of each report is S\$90 plus prevailing GST.

### 3. Can I purchase a report if the owner of the vehicle is a company?

At the moment, corporate vehicle owners are not able to purchase a report using Myinfo business. We are working with Govtech to make vehicle ownership information available on Myinfo business, and that would allow purchases by corporate owners.

### 4. What details will be included in the report?

Key details include:

- Date and Time the report was generated
- Vehicle Registration Number
- Chassis Number of Current Vehicle
- First registration date (when the vehicle was first registered with LTA)
- Vehicle Make and Model
- Date of accident
- Date of accident report submission

Please refer to *Appendix A* for a sample report.

### 5. Can I purchase a report if I don't have Singpass?

No, you cannot. The service relies on Singpass Myinfo to deliver the vehicle particulars after the current owner has authorised the transaction using Singpass.

### 6. Can I purchase a report if my vehicle number was transferred from another vehicle?

Yes, you can. As long as at the time of purchase, Myinfo records show that you are the registered owner of the vehicle.

### 7. Can I look up accidents that may have occurred more than 6 years ago?

Accident reports that are older than 6 years are removed from the database and will not be shown.

**8. What mode(s) of payment are accepted?**

PayNow and Credit Card.

**9. I would like to purchase the accident report history for the different vehicles that I own. Can I do so in one transaction?**

Each transaction will allow for the purchase of the accident report history for one vehicle. The buyer will have to pay the fee for each transaction/purchase made.

**10. How is this different from GIA Record Management Center's (GIARMC) Third Party Accident Report purchase?**

The GIARMC Third Party Accident Report purchase allows vehicle owners or drivers to purchase the Accident Report of another vehicle (the Third Party), provided that your vehicle was involved in the same accident. This report is mainly used for motor insurance claim purposes.

The Accident Report History report provides the history of Accident Report(s) that have been made by the vehicle owner or driver, or another vehicle's owner or driver, to the insurer.

**11. If I lose the initial copy of the report, can I redownload the report again?**

No. You will need to purchase the report again.

**12. Can I send the report to multiple email addresses?**

No. The report will be sent to the email address in Myinfo records by default. If the email address is outdated, you will have the option to indicate a different email address for the sending of the report, at the point of application.

If there is no email address in Myinfo records, you will need to enter an email address for the sending of the report.

In addition, users have the option to download the report from the screen.

**Disclaimer**

- The accident report history is linked to the Vehicle Registration Number (VRN). As the VRN may have been transferred across vehicles, this report will show the past records of accident reports made by that VRN even if it is not the current vehicle.
- The report will show only records of accident reports that have been made by the vehicle owner or driver, or another other vehicle's owner or driver, to the insurer. If the vehicle owner or driver, or other parties, did not report an accident to their insurer for any reason, there is no record of the accident report in the database.
- If the Vehicle make and model column shows Reported by other party, this means the vehicle owner or driver did not make an accident report, and an accident report was made by another vehicle's owner or driver.
- The report will show records up to 6 years from the date of the query.
- A record of an accident report does not make any conclusions that repair has been made to the vehicle.
